1960 Flown Space Air Mail Cover to NASA's First Administrator, the Honorable T. Keith Glennan

Exceptionally RARE and FLOWN space mail cover by U.S. satellite Discoverer 17. This rare cover was contained in the Discoverer 17 satellite launched by the U.S. Air Force into orbit from Vandenberg Air Force Base, California, November 12, 1960, and subsequently recovered by C-119 aircraft over the mid-Pacific Ocean.

A USAF fact sheet accompanying the flown cover states, "On the thirty-first pass, after traveling approximately one million miles, the capsule from Discoverer 17 was released from the orbiting satellite at 2:31 pm PST. At 3:05 pm PST, Captain Gene W. Jones piloting C-119 Pelican II snagged the capsule on his first attempt (over the mid-Pacific)."
